

MISSION APPEAL

The Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Batticaloa, cradled in Eastern coastal belt of Sri Lanka, was created as a new diocese in July 2012 by Pope Francis. To continue its work of evangelization and to provide spiritual support to the laity and to promote vocations, the new diocese wishes to focus on training of priests, religious and lay ministers. The support given by the mission appeal will help toward this training programme. Part of it will be used for a mobile clinic that is made available to the poor children and mothers in remote villages with the help of seminarians, religious and lay volunteers.
