

BLESSING OF THROATS -

Feast of Saint Blaise Friday, February 3

Blaise is the patron saint of wild animals because of his care for them and of those with throat maladies. Two candles are blessed, held slightly open, and pressed against the throat as the blessing is said. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. The boy was about to die when Saint Blaise healed him.
