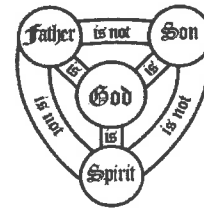

As counsellors helped her search for an affordable apartment, she became pregnant a second time. Despite these challenges, Camila attended every program available to her at Rose of Sharon. At the end of the year, she walked out a stronger woman with a plan to achieve the life she wants for herself and her daughters. Holy Hour in Honour of Corpus Christi

In thanksgiving and to honour our Lord in the Eucharist we will have a Holy Hour and, weather permitting, a procession on Sunday, June 3rd beginning at 2:00 p.m. to celebrate the gift of the Eucharist which is the centre and the origin of the life of the Church.

All Eucharistic devotion is related to the sacrifice of the Mass, which perpetuates Jesus' death and resurrection. Holy Thursday actually marks the anniversary of the institution of the Eucharist. But since it comes at a time when the commemoration of Jesus' passion and death overshadows everything else, the Church has given us this feast to bring out the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday, the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. May we always give thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

1323 "At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Saviour instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood. This he did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he should come again, and so to entrust to his beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of his death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.'" - *Catechism of the Catholic Church*
