If you would like to receive all notifications or just when we post a funeral at our parish you can signup by using your desktop computer or your mobile device by following the steps below.

Desktop Computer:

- 1. On your search engine type in stjohntheevangelistwe.archtoronto.org.
- 2. Click on **SIGNUP** (in red) on the right hand side.
- 3. Fill in your personal information such as first name, last name, e-mail and confirm e-mail.
- 4. Click on a box to be notified immediately, daily or weekly; then click on all or whichever box you want to receive notifications on (e.g., News, ShareLife, Parish Social, Celebrations) or, if you just want to receive notification on funerals at our parish, click box for Funerals only.
- 5. Click on **Receive Alerts** and, if you wish to receive Parish Bulletins click on **Receive Parish Bulletins**.
- Click on Subscribe. Once you click on Subscribe, a message confirming your subscription will be sent shortly to the email address you provided.

Mobile Devices:

- 1. On your search engine type in stjohntheevangelistwe.archtoronto.org.
- 2. Upper right hand corner click on the menu icon (three horizontal lines), then Contact Us and Sign up.
- 3. Follow steps 3, 4, 5 and 6 as above.
