

St. Pio's Relics at St. Philip Neri Parish

"Pray, hope and don't worry. Worry is useless. God is merciful and will hear your prayers." This is perhaps St. Pio's most well-known saying encouraging us to trust in God at all times. Trust in God is what guided Padre Pio through his earthly journey bearing the painful stigmata one century ago.

September 18 to 19, the relics of St. Pio will be coming to the Archdiocese of Toronto for the first time. Some of the relics on display at St. Philip Neri Parish in Toronto will include St. Pio's mantle - the brown cloak worn by Capuchin friars - as well as one of the gloves he wore to cover his wounds and a lock of his hair.

Public veneration of the relics will take place at St. Philip Neri Parish (2100 Jane St., near Wilson) on Tuesday, September 18, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., followed by a Trilingual (English, Spanish & Italian) Mass at 7:30 p.m., concelebrated by Bishop John A. Boissonneau. Public veneration will continue Wednesday, September 19, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. at St. Philip Neri Parish.

All are invited to visit during the day at your convenience and attend Mass. Please bring white flowers in a pot or vase to place around the Altar and Sanctuary on Monday, September 17 before 7:00 p.m. All are encouraged to bring a light potluck dish down to the Basement Hall #1 before Mass on Tuesday, September 18.
