To better serve the Catholic population that finds themselves under hospital care, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned three priests full-time as hospital Chaplains at the Etobicoke General Hospital and the Humber River Hospital.

This new improvement allows priests to be on-call 24/7 and, at the same time, it allows them to visit patients during the day since the ministry of these three priests is dedicated to provide pastoral care to those in hospital.

If you have a family member in need of anointing of the sick or a pastoral visit, please go to the nurses station or speak to a social worker at the hospital and they will contact one of the Catholic priests that is on-call to provide full-time pastoral care.
