The Gospel According to St. John

How well do you know Jesus? Do you want to get to know Him better? Have you ever really encountered Him? Have you been waiting a long time to do so?

On Tuesday, March 26, immediately following the 7:00 p.m. Mass, we will be showing:

Session Four: Nicodemus Encounters Jesus. Nicodemus was a well-educated, highly respected Pharisee. He is described as a "ruler of the Jews," meaning he was probably a member of the Sanhedrin, the Jewish high court. Nicodemus goes to see Jesus because he is seeking answers. He has seen the signs and heard the rumors about Jesus. Now he wants to discover for himself who Jesus really is.

Session Five: Two Wayward Women Encounters

Jesus. Forgiveness was at the center of Jesus' public life and message - He forgave sinners and taught His followers the importance of forgiving one another. In the Gospel of Saint John, we find two powerful stories about Jesus inviting two sinful women to experience a fresh start in life - to experience redemption. These two women appear only in this Gospel.
