The Gospel According to St. John

Tuesday, April 2, 2019 (immediately following the 7:00 p.m. Mass)

Session Six: Hungry Crowds Encounters Jesus. This session begins with Jesus performing His fourth and fifth signs, feeding five thousand people with five barley loaves and two fish and walking on water. This session, with its focus on the Bread of Life, forms the foundation for our love and devotion to the Eucharist as the centerpiece of our faith.

Read: John 13-15 Focus: John 6:22-69

Session Seven: Lazarus, Martha and Mary Encounters Jesus. Jesus risks His life to give life to His friend, Lazarus, when Martha and Mary request it. It is the last of Jesus' seven signs (raises His beloved friend, Lazarus, from the dead) and sets the stage for the Passion narrative.

Read: John 16-18 Focus: John 11:1-12:11


Society of Saint Vincent de Paul What an opportunity!


base for the main Altar and base for the statue of Mary.

The original wooden altar with the stucco base was consecrated on May 30, 1955 by Rev. Thomas B. Fulton. This altar was embedded with a stone containing bone fragments from St. Blandina and St. Amatoris who are early church martyrs. The altar top was placed over the wooden altar during Fr. Casullo's time. That marble altar top is reused in the present altar and the original altar stone containing the relics from 1955 are also placed in the new altar base.

The marble portion that was part of the old tabernacle was reused as a top for Mary's statue with a new base donated by the Knights of Columbus.

The existing marble lectern was also redone to match the lines of the new marble items, baseboard and shelves were installed.

We are so grateful for all the support the Knights of Columbus has shown to St. John the Evangelist Parish.
