

In his message, Pope Francis reminds us that "the presence of migrants and refugees, is an invitation to recover some of those essential dimensions of our Christian existence and our humanity that risk being overlooked in a prosperous society. That is why it is not just about migrants. *'For if you love those who love you, what recompense will you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same?'* (Matt:5:46)."

A special Mass will be celebrated on Sunday, September 29 at 4:30 p.m. at St. Philip Neri Catholic Church, located at 2100 Jane Street, North York.
