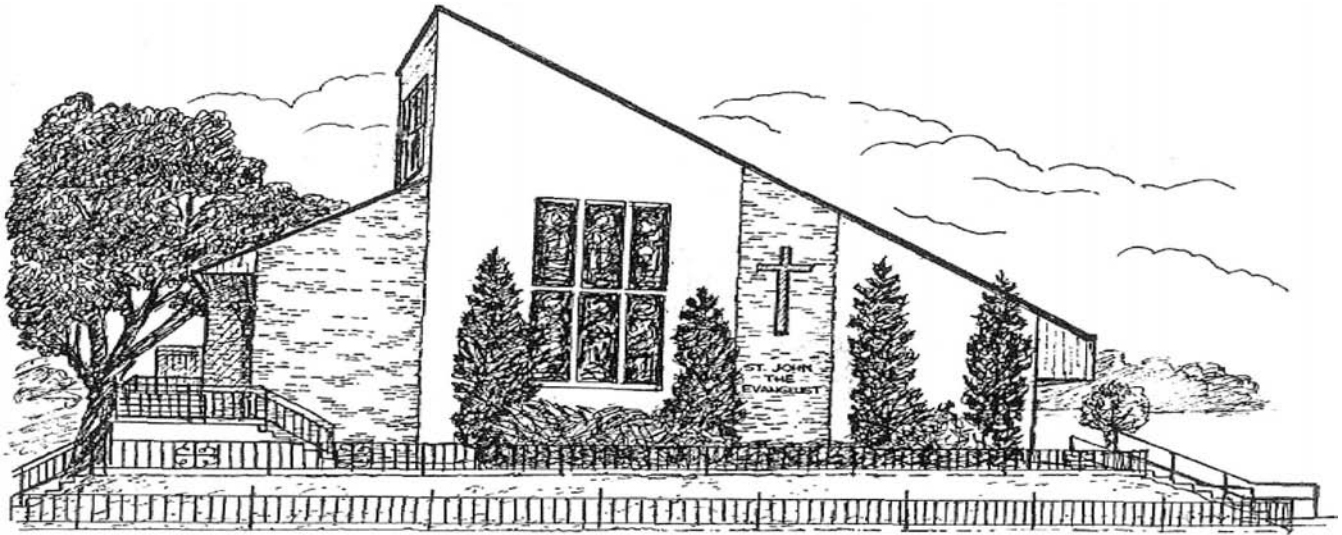

A special Mass will be celebrated on Sunday, September 29 at 4:30 p.m. at St. Philip Neri Catholic Church, located at 2100 Jane Street, North York. Bishop Lawrence Saldanha will preside at the Divine liturgy. The homilist will be Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick. Mass will begin at 4:30 p.m., followed by a presentation at 5:30 p.m. The program will focus on the plight of Pakistani Christians. All are welcome.

### ***Annual day of public witness for children killed by abortion***



A small pro-life group called *Please Let Me Live* in Yuba City, California held the first Life Chain in 1987, and the United States has had a National Life Chain every year since. Campaign Life Coalition brought Life Chain into

Canada from the U.S. in 1990, igniting a powerful public witness in our country that has endured the test of years, saved lives and changed hearts. Life Chain is held simultaneously in more than 200 locations across Canada each year.

Life Chain is a prayerful, peaceful witness to the evil of abortion and to the sanctity of human life from the moment of conception. Join pro-lifers in your community and across Canada to pray for the end to abortion. On **Sunday, October 6, 2019 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.** show up for one hour, stand on the sidewalk with others who are not ashamed to be a public witness, and pray for an end to abortion and for those affected by it. **Our church location will be Jane & Lawrence.**
