

(Mark 14:61) Jesus' Arrest and Trial Before the Sanhedrin

Soldiers, police, captains, chief priests, and elders of the people come to arrest Jesus in Gethsemane. They are led there by Judas, who has betrayed his Master. They come with torches, lanterns, swords, and clubs. And they come in large numbers. We will see how Jesus is not taken by surprise. Nor is He taken by force against His will. The Gospels highlight how He is actually the one in charge during His arrest, and He freely allows the crowd to hand Him over to the chief priests.
