

Life Chain is held simultaneously in more than 200 locations across Canada each year. Please mark your calendar - the next Life Chain will be on Sunday, October 4, 2020 from 2 - 3 p.m. Our location will be at the corners of Jane St. & Lawrence Ave.

How Does it Work?

Life Chain is an easy way to get involved in pro-life witness. Just show up for one hour to stand on the sidewalk with others who are not ashamed to publicly witness to their pro-life beliefs. Your local Life Chain organizer will provide you with a non-graphic Life Chain sign to hold, and you may pray silently for an end to abortion and for those affected by it.

What about COVID-19?

All Life Chain organizers are asked to abide by local COVID-19 safety protocols and participants are asked to review the full list of <u>Life Chain Code</u> of <u>Conduct</u> and abide by the updated <u>Life Chain Code</u> of Conduct.

- Please bring hand sanitizer and a mask or face covering and use as needed.
- Please maintain a 2-metre distance from fellow Life Chain participants and passersby at all times.
- Please follow all instructions from your local Life Chain organizer, especially ones pertaining to local COVID-19 protocols.

Please DO NOT attend Life Chain if you:

- **a.** are feeling ill or have (or suspect you could have) COVID-19.
- **b.** have had close contact with someone in the past days who is ill or has or is suspected to have COVID-19.
- **c.** have travelled out-of-country in the past 14 days
- **d.** are worried about the risk to your own health or the health of someone in your social circle.
