

At St. John the Evangelist Parish, York (Weston), our parish will be having a Holy Hour and Rosary from 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. this Sunday, October 11, 2020 in solidarity with other people throughout the country in asking our Lady of the Rosary to heal our country and return it to Holiness. <u>Please note</u>: the same social distancing protocol in use at our Masses will also be in use during the Rosary. Masks are mandatory for those who do not have a medical exemption, and seating will be limited. The overflow area in the Parish Hall will also be open should a need arise for the Rosary to be streamed _downstairs.

We continue to live in peace-less times with laws and court rulings in conflict with God's laws; especially the disregard for the rights of the unborn, elderly and weak in our society and the attacks on marriage and family values.
