

SAINTS' RELICS

On a Catecheis post on our Facebook page from earlier this week, a parishioner asked the question as to which saints' relics are found in our altar at St. John the Evangelist Parish. Below is an excerpt from a bulletin announcement that we posted on March 31, 2019.

"The original wooden altar with the stucco base was consecrated on May 30, 1955 by Rev. Thomas B. Fulton. This altar was embedded with a stone containing bone fragments from St. Blandina and St. Amatoris who are early church martyrs. The altar top was placed over the wooden altar during Fr. Casullo's time. That marble altar top is reused in the present altar and the original altar stone containing the relics from 1955 are also placed in the new altar just below the surface on the side that the priest stands."

You must have the exact amount of \$5.00, no change will be available.
