

COMMUNION

SERVICES

Although the Cardinal has suspended all public Masses in Toronto due to COVID-19, he has given permission to hold Communion Services on weekends. There is a limit of 10 people permitted in the Church for each service - including the Priest and staff. Masses will be continued to be livestreamed at 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays (vigil Mass) and on Sundays at 9:00 a.m. The **11:00 a.m. Mass will not take place** and therefore will not be livestreamed so as to allow for more Holy Communion services as needed. It would be wonderful if people could watch the Mass livestreamed and then join us to receive Our Lord in one of the services after.

You must register for these services through Eventbrite:

Registration opens up Monday mornings at 10:00 a.m. Please note that each person attending will require **one ticket per person (including infants and children)**.

This Communion Service will be approximately 10 minutes long with the Liturgy of the Word and then Communion. Please remember that you are receiving Our Lord in the Eucharist so the same preparation still applies - please make sure you observe an hour fast (with exception for medication) before receiving our Lord. Please ensure that you arrive at least 10 minutes before the service as the doors will be locked at the start time of the service. This will also allow you some time for quiet prayer in the Church.

All Social Distancing protocols must continue to be followed. Every reasonable precaution has been and will continue to be taken by the Archdiocese of Toronto to protect your health and safety. However, there can be no guarantees of complete protection as there will always be risks of contracting viral infection through gatherings.
