## **GOOD NEWS!**

As of June 11th, as Ontario begins Step 1 in its Roadmap to reopening, we have been given the go ahead to celebrate Mass once again, with a capacity of 15% at the Church. Attendance for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Vigil Mass and Sunday at 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. will be by reservation on <u>Eventbrite</u> (ttps://www.eventbrite.ca/o/st-john-the-evangelistrc-church-weston-30498290002) or by calling the office on Monday mornings from 10:00 a.m. on to book a spot for the upcoming weekend (please do not call before 10:00 a.m.). Weekday Masses will be on a first come, first serve basis respecting the 15% capacity limit.

Since we only received the news on Monday about being able to open, we had already released the spots for the previously scheduled Holy Communion Services this weekend. Because the people who had signed up were already scheduled to attend Church this weekend, their bookings were transferred to the various Masses.

You are asked to please read the instructions for sign up carefully as it is imperative that we stay within the 15% limit. This means that only 45 people can be in the Church at one time, including Fr. Maderak, musicians and staff. 1 spot must be reserved for 1 person attending, or for 2 people from the same household. 2 spots must be reserved for 3-7 family members from the same household. You must list all people attending by name. Your reservation may be cancelled if you fail to do this.
