2020 Parish Financial Statement

The finance statement for 2020 has been included in this week's bulletin.

As the pandemic started last year in March, I was very much encouraged, that despite the shutdown of the churches, people continued to support the Church and some showed greater generosity. People would call and ask how they could make their donation to the Church. Despite the fact that many continued to contribute to the parish, in a generous way, the lack of regular crowds of parishioners on the weekend took a significant toll on our Offertory collection. After we compared the 2019 to 2020 average weekly collection we found that it decreased by 28.5% (\$3112 to \$2226). Our weekly preauthorized giving program (PAG) did not change from 2019 to 2020, it remained at \$216 per week.

We would have suffered a loss of \$44,638 in 2020 if not for the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy that covered part of our payroll. We received \$35,102 from the government last year which resulted in a shortfall of \$9,535.00. Unfortunately, during the pandemic the expenses did not decrease significantly, only small changes in utilities.

Thus far this year, as of June 27, we are down a further 12% from 2020 already. This amounts to a total of 37% drop between 2019 and this present year. With a decrease of over 70% in the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy for this year, we are bracing for severe losses that are not sustainable. Even though we are presently at Stage 3 of reopening we will still be limited to low numbers (about 25%, including the hall) due to social distancing requirements.

Once again, a heartfelt thank you to all those parishioners that are caring for St. John the Evangelist Parish through their contributions. For those that can it would be greatly appreciated if you could increase your contribution. It would also be very helpful if you could make your contribution through the Pre-authorized Giving program. This allows us to have a more consistent revenue stream to pay ongoing bills.

What is the Pre-Authorized Giving Plan?

Through the Archdiocese of Toronto, St. John the Evangelist has established a *Pre-Authorized Giving Plan* to assist you in your support of the work of St. John the Evangelist Parish through your regular parish offerings (**this does not include special collections**). Advantages for the donor is the convenience of your offering being received automatically every month (to be withdrawn from your account on the 20th day of each month) and your continual support of your parish when you are away or during lockdowns.

Pre-Authorized Giving Plan forms can be found at the counter in the church foyer or they can be emailed directly to you. Just fill out the form and attach a cheque from your account marked "void." Once completed, put the form and void cheque in a sealed envelope, place it in the donation box in the church foyer or place it in our grey dropbox at the Rectory door.

Step 3 of Provincial Reopening as of July 16, 2021

As of July 16, 2021, Ontario has moved to Step 3 as part of the "Roadmap for Reopening" plan. Step 3 does not include any capacity restrictions for places of worship, however, parishioners need to maintain physical distancing of two meters (six feet) between those not from the same household. As the physical distancing restrictions still remain in place, our seating configurations will not change. We must still keep social distancing protocol, so the number of people at each Mass will depend on and differ due to the fact that there may be families, couples or singles attending. **A reminder that for 1 person attending, you must book 1 seat. For 2 people from the same household, 1 seat must be booked, but both first names must be listed. For families of 3 people up to 7 people living in the same household, 2 seats must be booked but all first names must be listed.**

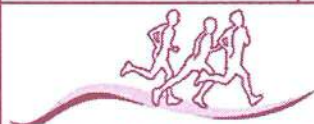
