Because of its simplicity, this one-hour peaceful, prayerful, and public pro-life witness may strike one as unimportant, yet its simplicity is precisely what makes this event so important. Anyone can participate - young and old, the inexperienced and experienced, city dwellers and rural residents. You don't have to travel far. You don't have to spare much time.

I like to think of Life Chain as the inverse of the National March for Life. Instead of thousands of pro-lifers all flocking to Canada's capital to bring our lawmakers the message that abortion is an injustice, these thousands of pro-lifers take this message onto the streets of their own communities. We may be physically separated from each other, but spiritually we are unified on this one day - the first Sunday of October - in a chain that stretches coast to coast, in both Canada and the United States. Know that God continues to use this annual event to call His children into the pro-life movement, to touch the consciences of post-abortive men and women, and to provide a sign to those with abortion appointments scheduled that they are headed down the wrong path.
