



REMEMBRANCE DAY

Canadians pause on November 11 in silence to remember those who died in war and to pray for the victims of aggression and inhumanity throughout the world. This is a day to pray for peace, to consider what we are doing as individuals, as a community and as a nation to bring God's peace into the world. This is a day when a believing community should rededicate itself by prayer and action to the ideals Jesus gives us in the beatitudes.

NEW SEATING CAPACITY

Our Church seating capacity has increased by another 30% due to the directive of the Chancery to move from every third pew to every second pew. There will still be social distancing between different households in each pew.

The present protocol for weekend Mass registration will remain the same (1 spot must be reserved for 1 person attending, or for 2 people from the same household. 2 spots must be reserved for 3-7 family members from the same household. You must list all people attending by name). Attendance for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Vigil Mass and Sunday at 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. will be by reservation on Eventbrite: (ttps://www.eventbrite.ca/o/st-john-the-evangelist-r c-church-weston-30498290002)

or by calling the office on Monday mornings from 10:00 a.m. on to book a spot for the upcoming weekend (please do not call before 10:00 a.m.). Weekday Masses will remain on a first come, first serve basis. We will continue to keep the hall open for overflow seating on a first come, first serve basis.
