2022 Offertory Envelopes

Offertory envelopes for 2022 are available but, due to FERING COVID-19, the offertory

envelopes will not be put out on the shelves as usual. If you register for Mass through Eventbrite, and you use offertory envelopes, your box set of Sunday Offering envelopes will be placed in the pew where you will be seated.

If you do not register for Mass but go downstairs in the parish hall for overflow seating, and you use Sunday Offering envelopes, please call the office no later than 3:00 p.m. Friday to let us know and we will put your envelopes out for pickup in the church foyer.

This year we reduced our order of the number of box set of offertory envelopes for 2022 to cut down on the cost as 2021 Sunday Offertory envelopes cost \$1,296.56 and over half of the envelopes were not picked up. Therefore, if your current envelope number is 281 or higher, you have been assigned a new envelope number for 2022. Please verify the name on the box of envelopes to make sure you pick up only the box with your name on it.

Using envelopes allows us to know that you are a practicing member of St. John the Evangelist Parish. It is important that we have a way of knowing you when you request baptism, marriage or letters of reference.

Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God January 1st



This feast recognized Mary as the physical parent of Christ, the God-Man defined at the Council of Ephesus in the 5th century. The third Mass of Christmas reflects the role of Mary in the Redemption, so her role has always been connected with the Christmas Mystery. Later from the 5th century to the 7th century, the feast was transferred to the Octave

Day of Christmas, January 1.

Prior to the time that this feast occurred on January 1, New Year's Day was observed as a day of prayer to offset pagan practices, since there were many riotous pagan celebrations. In the 5th century until the Middle Ages it honoured Mary and her Divine Maternity. Then it was observed as the Octave of Christmas, which developed into the Feast of the Circumcision. From 1961 to 1969 the title changed back to the Octave of the Nativity. Finally in 1969 the ancient Marian character was restored, so that we have its present title. It is a Holy day of Obligation.

This Solemnity celebrates the part played by Mary in the Mystery of Salvation, exalts the singular dignity that this Mystery brings to the holy Mother, renews adoration to the newborn Prince of Peace. and implores from God, through Mary's intercession, the supreme gift of peace.
