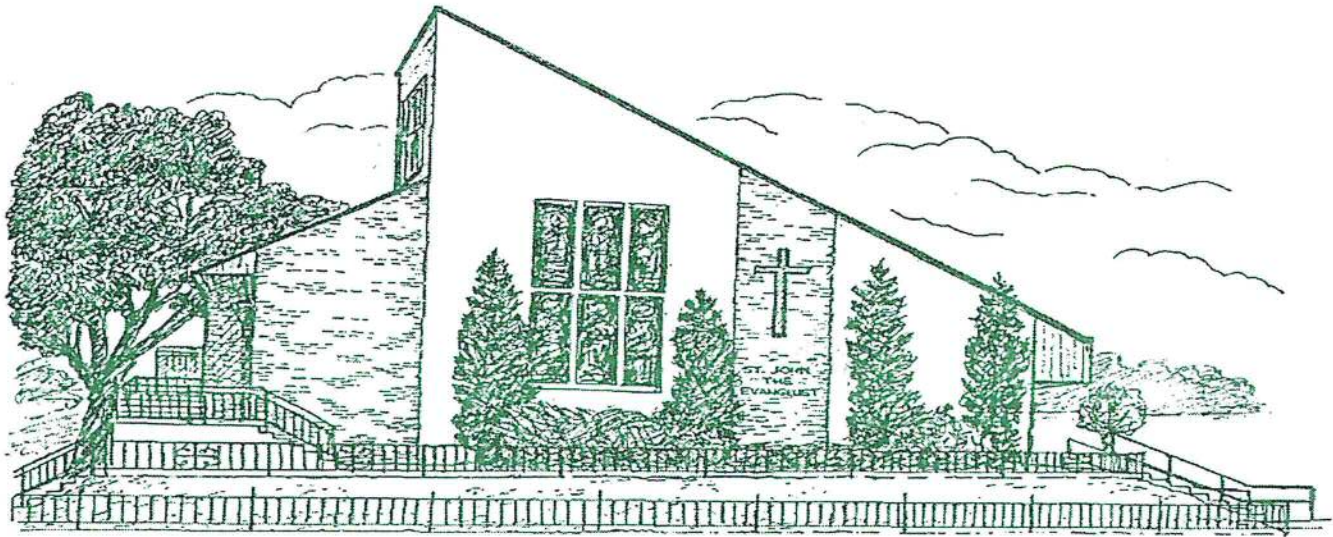

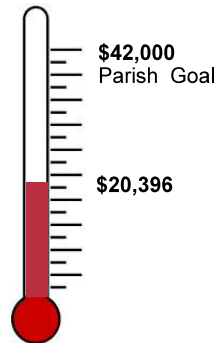
**Sick:** That the world may see clearly the love we have for the sick.

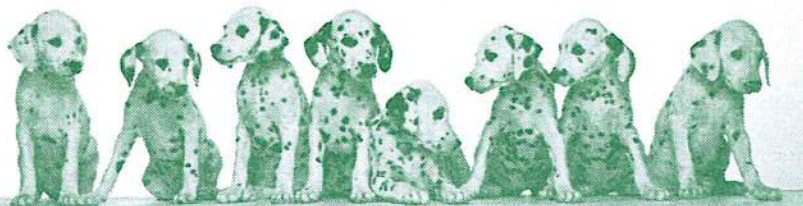
