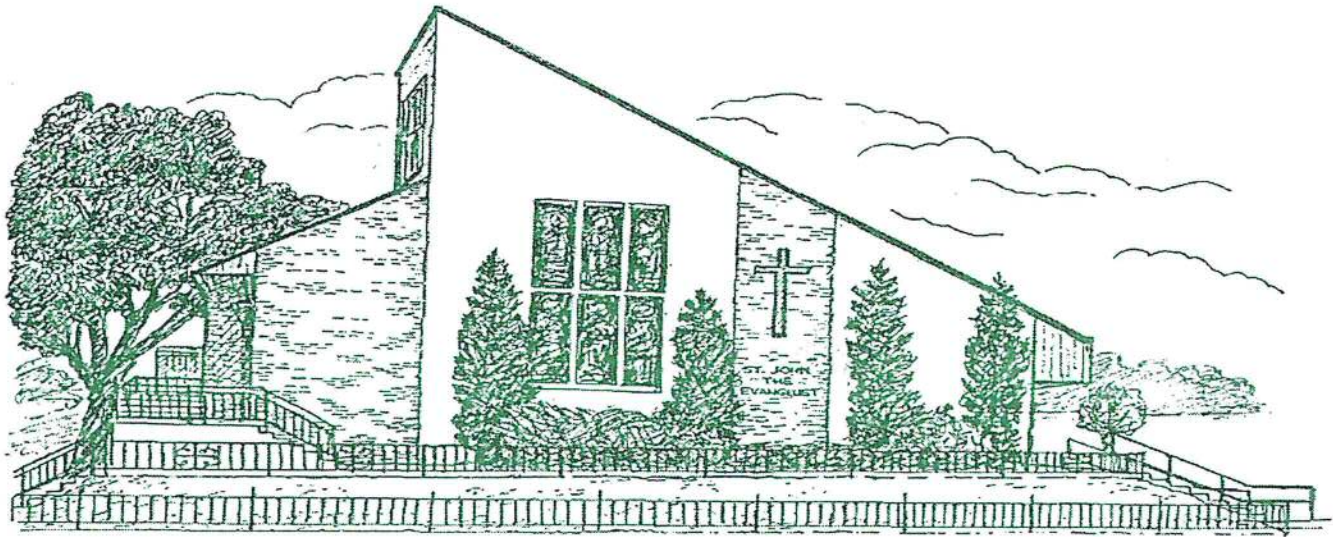

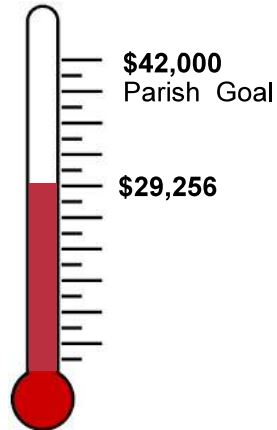

**Holy Hour In Honour Of Corpus Christi**



In thanksgiving and to honour our Lord in the Eucharist we will have a Holy Hour and, weather permitting, a procession next **Sunday, June 19<sup>th</sup> beginning at 2:00 p.m.** to celebrate the gift of the Eucharist which is the centre and the origin of the life of the Church.

All Eucharistic devotion is related to the sacrifice of the Mass, which perpetuates Jesus' death and resurrection. Holy Thursday actually marks the anniversary of the institution of the Eucharist. But since it comes at a time when the commemoration of Jesus' passion and death overshadows everything else, the Church has given us this feast to bring out the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday, the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. May we always give thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

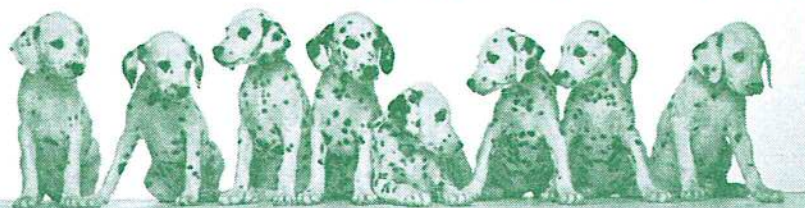
