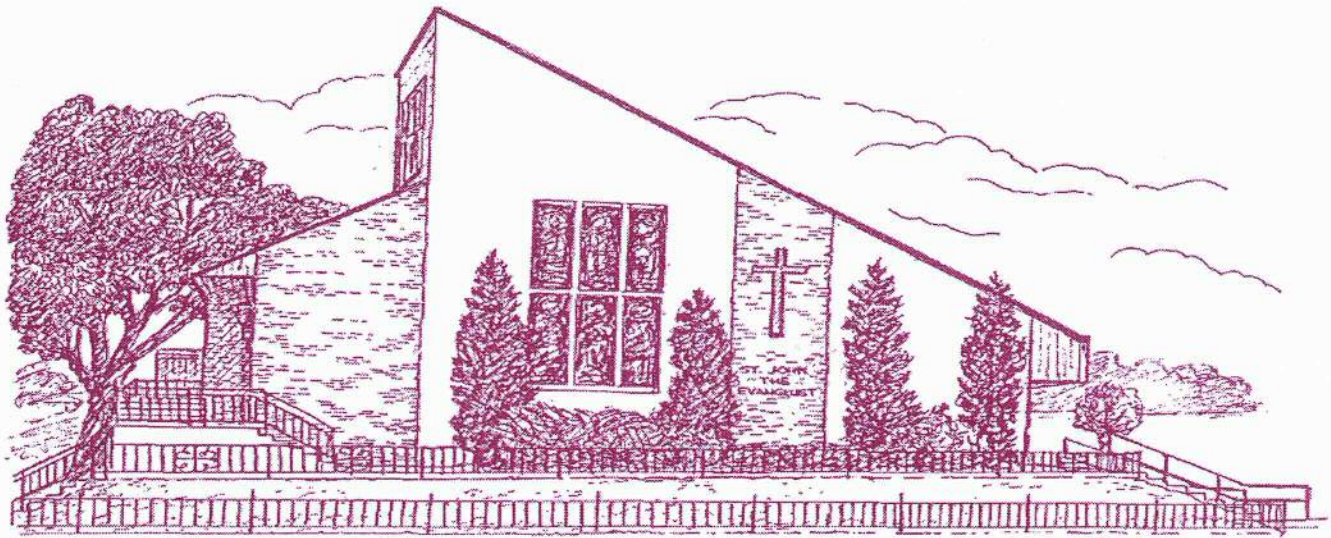

SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Just a reminder for those who may have missed the announcement on the weekend of June 4/5, we will no longer be livestreaming the Masses. The dispensation from Sunday Mass attendance has now ended, and the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is once again in effect.

The Code of Canon Law states:

Can. 1247 On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass.

Moreover, they are to abstain from those works and affairs which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's day, or the suitable relaxation of mind and body.

Of course the Church does not ask for what is impossible. The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us:

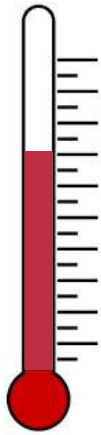
CCC 2181 The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.

If you fall into the category of those for whom attending Mass is impossible, did you know that you can reach out to the Church to have someone bring you Holy Communion? If you are a Parishioner and wish to receive Holy Communion, please contact the Church.

Holy Hour In Honour Of Corpus Christi this Sunday afternoon at 2:00 p.m.



In thanksgiving and to honour our Lord in the Eucharist we will have a Holy Hour and, weather permitting, a procession **this Sunday, June 19th beginning at 2:00 p.m.** to celebrate the gift of the Eucharist which is the centre and the origin of the life of the Church.

All Eucharistic devotion is related to the sacrifice of the Mass, which perpetuates Jesus' death and resurrection. Holy Thursday actually marks the anniversary of the institution of the Eucharist. But since it comes at a time when the commemoration of Jesus' passion and death overshadows everything else, the Church has given us this feast to bring out the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday, the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. May we always give thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

1323 "At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Saviour instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood. This he did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he should come again, and so to entrust to his beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of his death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.'"
