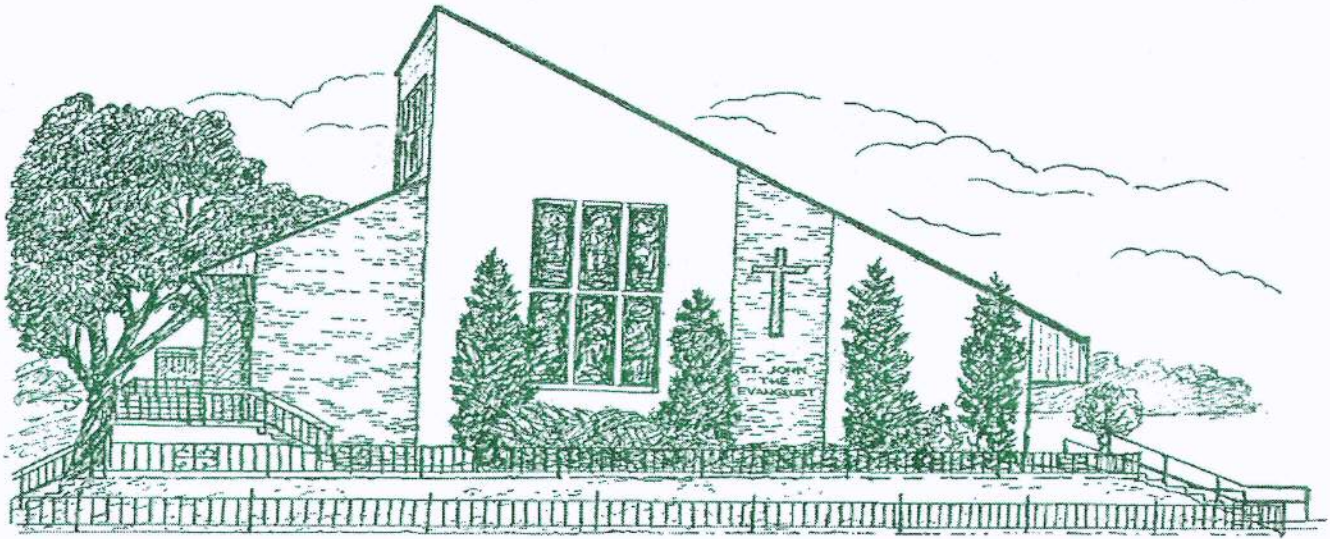

OCTOBER ROSARY



The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7. It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.

During the month of October, the Rosary will be recited after all weekday Masses. Everyone is welcome to participate. If you do not have a rosary, or know how to pray the rosary, rosaries and pamphlets on how to pray the rosary are available for free at the counter in the church foyer.



Email Scams

Please be aware that the Archdiocese of Toronto have received multiple reports of fraudulent emails targeting our parishes, parishioners and departments. The scammers are posing as priests, Cardinal Collins and in one case, a bishop. In some instances, they are asking that the recipient email back in order to discuss a favour. In other cases, they are asking for gift cards.

To protect against email scams, please change your email password regularly. If you receive a suspicious email from someone you know or someone who is requesting gift cards or money, please contact them on a trusted phone number to ensure they actually sent you the message. No one from the Archdiocese of Toronto will ask you for gift cards. If the sender's information seems odd or if the message is out of character for the sender, do not reply to the message.

Our country continues to undergo an examination of our relationships with Indigenous Peoples. The Catholic Church in Canada has been deeply engaged in the journey of healing and reconciliation, most notably through the visit of Pope Francis this past summer. As part of our ongoing efforts, the Archdiocese of Toronto has made a firm commitment to provide funds in support of programs and initiatives that respond to the various needs that exist among Indigenous Peoples both locally and throughout the country.

The Indigenous Healing & Reconciliation fund is part of a national effort announced by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. The Bishops of Canada have made a \$30-million collective financial commitment to support healing and reconciliation initiatives among Indigenous Peoples. The archdiocese will contribute six million dollars towards the national pledge. The collection this weekend provides an opportunity for the faithful to contribute to this important initiative.
