

For those who have not yet reached heaven, but are in purgatory, we are assisting them in their struggle of purification. This is a great help to them and we will only know in the next world how much it meant to them. Before her death St. Monica said to her son St. Augustine, "Bury my body wherever you will;...One thing only I ask you, that you remember me at the altar of the Lord wherever you may be."

During the month of November, beginning with The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day), a **Book of Remembrance** containing the names of deceased relatives and friends will be placed near the statue of Our Lady during the month of November.
