

WHAT IS THE PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN?

The Archdiocese of Toronto has established a Pre-Authorized Giving Plan (PAG) to assist you in your support of the work of



the parish through your regular parish offerings (this does not include special collections). The Parish depends entirely on the generosity of our parishioners. Pre-authorized giving allows you to give to the Parish intentionally and faithfully through scheduled transfers from your bank account or credit card. Once a month, your bank or credit card accounts will be automatically charged for the amount you specified. These funds are then deposited directly into the parish's account.

WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Advantages for the donor:

- ★ Convenience. Your offering is received automatically every month.
- ★ Continual support of your parish when you are away.

Advantages for the Parish:

- ★ Allows the parish to **plan better** through regular and dependable flow of contributions.

Today, Catholics throughout the Archdiocese are encouraged to participate in **Mental Health in the Faith Communities Awareness Sunday**.

Are you able to host a Ukrainian family?

When hearing reports of the war in Ukraine, and the millions of Ukrainians that have been forced to flee their homeland, many have asked what they can do to help.

Over 200,000 Ukrainians have already arrived in Canada through a special visa program created by Immigration Canada. An additional 800,000 have applied to the program and are expected to arrive in the coming months. Many are arriving to Toronto and are without family here in Canada to help them. Among those will be some who are vulnerable to human trafficking, particularly seniors, single women, and women with children. There is an immediate need for families to host for a period of between one and six months some of those who have arrived.
