




Spiritual Reading

by all women. It is a personal story of the author's life, its ups and downs and how she befriended the female saints along the way through readings, prayer and reflection. These friendships helped her in the many stages of her life.

The second book, a classic, "Introduction to the Devout Life" by St. Francis De Sales, is a must read for all who are serious about growing in holiness and helping themselves to eventually becoming saints. A warning though - this book is not for the faint of heart. St.

Francis De Sales is very direct in his approach and sometimes the honesty is to the point of being brutal. However, it causes the reader to really reflect about his or her life and whether he or she is really doing everything to be pleasing to God.
