

Paschal Fast

Good Friday is a universal day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Fasting means that only one meal be taken in a day; but it does not forbid taking some nourishment in the morning and evening.

"Abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter."

The Feast originated from apparitions of Jesus to Saint Faustina Kowalska in which He

said, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day...the soul that will go to confession (this can be eight days before or after the Feast) and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment... It is My desire that (the Feast) be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter."

The parish office will be closed on Good Friday, March 29th and Easter Monday, April 1st.
