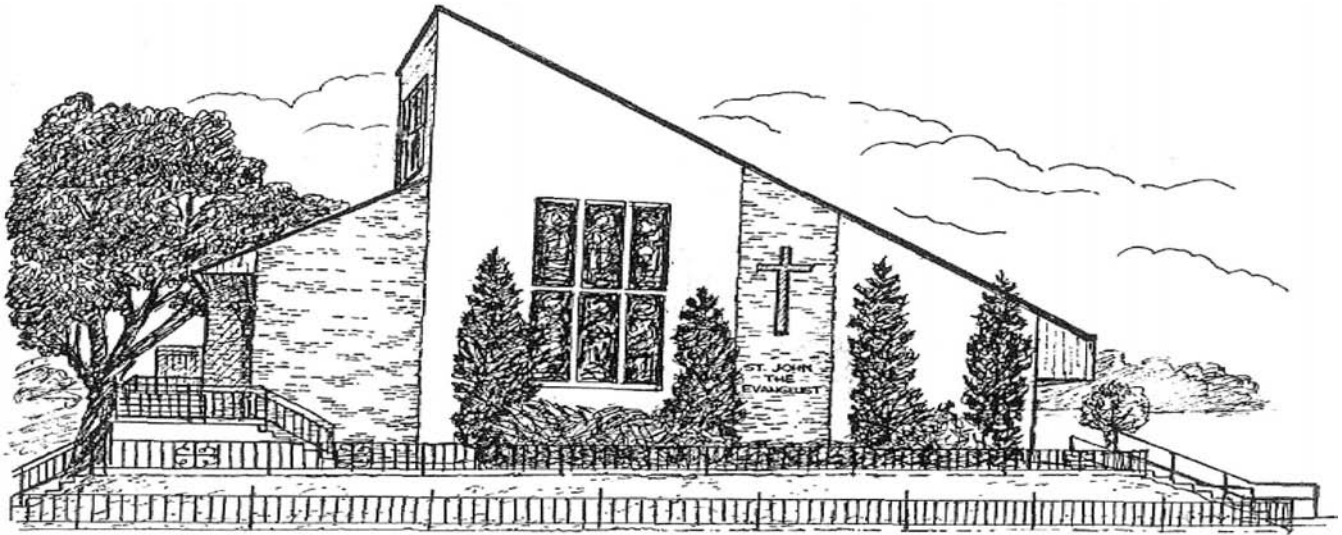

Before her death St. Monica said to her son St. Augustine, "Bury my body wherever you will;...One thing only I ask you, that you remember me at the altar of the Lord wherever you may be."
