World Day of the Poor - November 17

The prayer of the poor rises up to God (cf. Sir 21:5)



1 in 10 People in the GTA depended on Food Banks in 2023. In 2022, it was just 1 in 20. Ever since the pandemic, our most vulnerable neighbours have been living through an unprecedented hunger crisis. 1 in

3 of those who depended on food banks are living with a disability, and more than half missed a meal to pay for something else, like rent. Poverty is all around us in the GTA, and often it is hidden behind closed doors: among families, refugees, and others who struggle to afford the necessities of life.

You can help them, right here in our community.

Across the GTA, over 1,400 members of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul - including right here in our parish - visited our Neighbours in Need at home more than 30,000 times in 2023 alone, delivering vouchers to help them put food on the table. Together, Vincentians seek to follow in the footsteps of Jesus by helping those suffering most.
