

Divine Mercy Sunday "Could you spend one hour with Me?"



Come join us for the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday next Sunday, April 27, from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. for prayer, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction.

The Feast originated from apparitions of Jesus to Saint Faustina Kowalska in which He

said, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day...the soul that will go to confession (this can be eight days before or after the Feast) and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment... It is My desire that (the Feast) be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter."

A Day With Mary - May 31 Registration Now Open!

On Saturday, May 31 - the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary - the first annual archdiocesan "A Day With Mary" will be taking place outdoors at Villanova College in King City.

All are invited to gather together to participate in Mass with His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo, pray the Rosary, grow deeper in our devotion to Our Lady through a keynote address by Dr. Josephine Lombardi for the adults, and children's catechesis for the kids. There will be powerful witnessings, music, crafts, food, fellowship and more.
