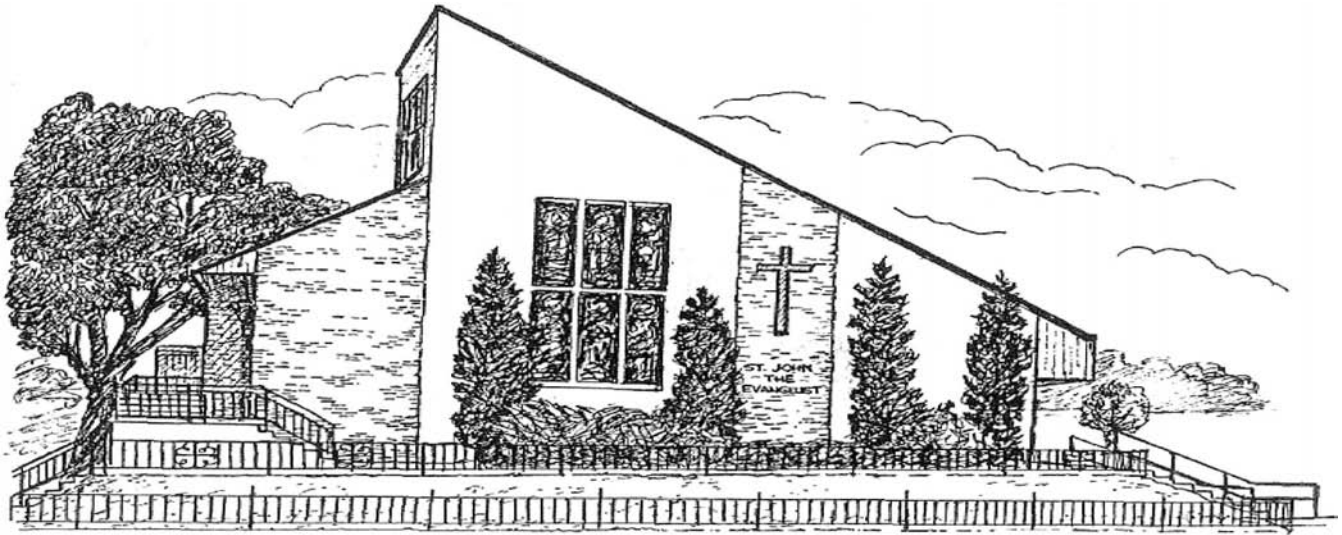

### Corpus Christi Procession and Good-bye Reception for Fr. Maderak

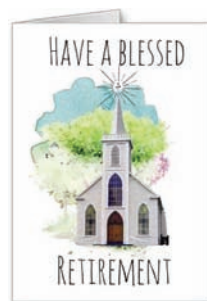
