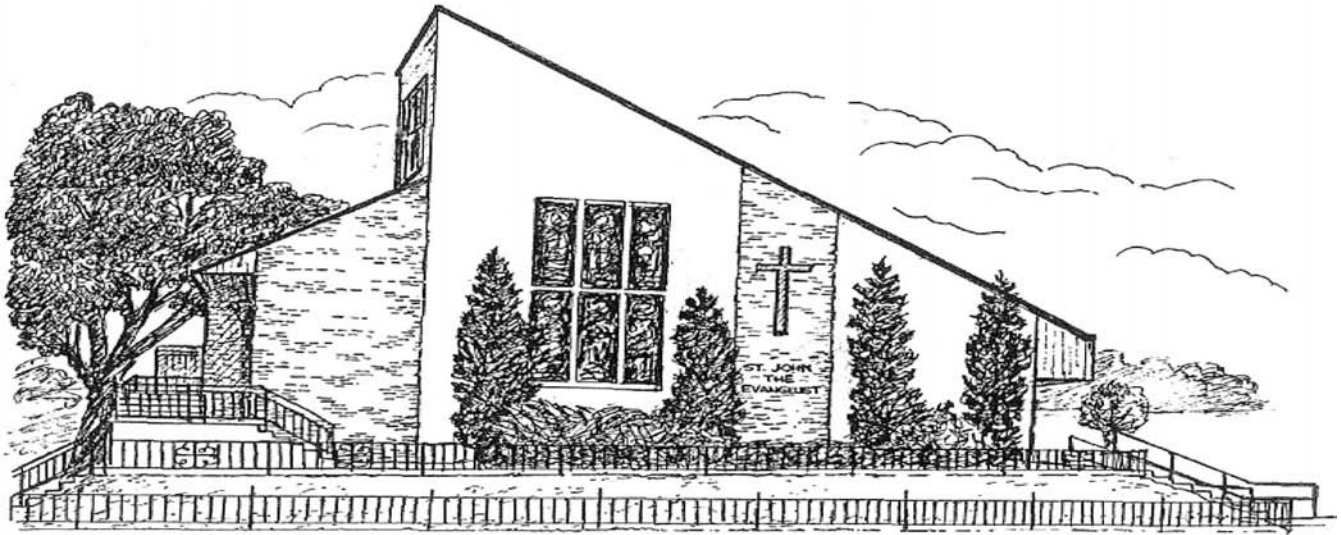

Mission Co-op Special Collection This weekend - July 11/12, 2026

St. John Paul II said that, ***“Some become missionaries by going to the missions; others go by giving to the missions; without both, there are no missions.”***

I am Fr. Donbosco Mawdsley, SMA. I belong to the Society of African Missions, a missionary congregation for Africa. I served in East Africa for 11 years, and at present I serve at an Italian parish in the Archdiocese of Montreal. I will be visiting your parish on a mission appeal on behalf of the Diocese of Shinyanga in Tanzania, on July 11th and 12th.

The proceeds that we will receive from the mission appeal will be used for the following missions:

i) Faith formation and evangelization in the diocese; ii) Education program: education for orphans and students from poor families, education for major and senior seminarians; iii) Constructions for Renewal Formation Center and Shanwa Minor Seminary; iv) Drilling shallow wells to supply clean and safe water.

Each orphan needs \$600.00 per year, which is about \$40 a month. Each student from a poor family needs \$700.00 dollars for school fees and tuition per year. Currently, we have 75 Seminarians who are pursuing their philosophical and Theological studies within the country. The diocese is supposed to contribute \$2,500.00 (twenty-five hundred) dollars per year for their formation: school fees, travelling expenses, medication, and boarding. We need your generous support for this vital priestly formation program. Most rural areas experience a severe and acute shortage of water. Therefore, we need your support to drill some shallow wells around or close to communities, which will provide clean and safe water. One shallow well costs about \$8,000.00.

I thank the Archdiocese, your parish and you for your goodness towards the missions and missionaries working in the Diocese of Shinyanga.

Venezuela Earthquake

A devastating series of earthquakes struck north-central Venezuela on June 24, 2026, making it the country's largest seismic disaster in more than a century. Two powerful earthquakes - a magnitude of 7.2 followed just 39 seconds later with a magnitude of 7.5 near Yumare/San Felipe in Yaracuy State, causing catastrophic damage across much of the country. Authorities declared a national state of emergency, while teams from Venezuela and numerous international partners continue to search for survivors.
