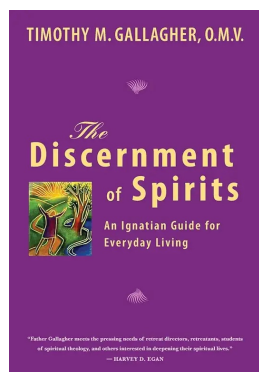
Congratulations
